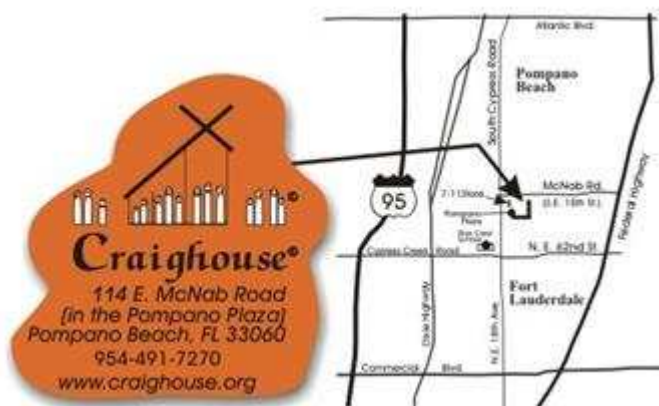

She will be praying for the sick as well. MCM is raising money to give to the street orphans ministered to by the AOG church there, some 900 orphans. In addition, the MCM team will be taking extra suitcases filled with clothing, school supplies, toys, toothbrushes, a new men's suit for a pastor there, and much more.
