We have several new things this month going on at Craighthouse®. They all involve transforming lives. It’s what the Holy Spirit does, through our proclaiming Christ and the power of His gospel to all God brings to our doors.



Tuesdays from 1:00-3:00 p.m. Jackie Marcott, R.N. leads a support group for those caring for the chronically ill. The Craighthouse Caregivers Support Group will provide encouragement, sharing, and spiritual support in a “one anothering” atmosphere of grace. Caregivers need care too!



Tuesday nights, Rev. Jim Craig teaches the work of the Holy Spirit in evangelism.

“Heart of Evangelism” 7:00-9:00 p.m. takes you through the order of salvation, from effectual calling to glorification. This class is helping Christians know the Holy Spirit and how He transforms lives as we take the gospel to the lost. It will encourage and inspire you to witness for Christ. Follow Jesus, and learn how to be a fisher of men.



Wednesday nights, 7:00-9:00 p.m. Dr. Mary Craig teaches “The Weapons of Our Warfare.” This 6-week course costs \$65.00 (includes materials) and begins May 2nd. Every war has weapons. Ours are spiritual. You will examine the spiritual weapons God has given His children as they wage war against the world, the flesh, and the devil in their personal lives. In this course you will learn to:

- Make personal preparations for spiritual power in Christ
- Arm yourself with defensive and offensive weapons
- Fight the good fight of faith
- Utilize the means of grace
- Overcome and walk in spiritual authority
- Place all that you are and have in God’s hands
- Take your place as a Christian soldier waging war against God’s enemies.



Friday nights, 7:30 -10:30 p.m. Dr. Mary Craig continues her teaching on “Prophets and the Prophetic Anointing.” This month we will be looking at the anointing of a prophet, the prophet’s call and commission, and how to discern true from false prophets/prophecies. Worship and ministry of the Holy Spirit follow the Bible study.

We are really seeing the Holy Spirit move Friday nights, both in the prophetic and in healing. Many are praising God for the transforming work the Holy Spirit is doing in their lives.
